

Airbus

- [Hong Kong Airlines](#) ordered six A330-200 aircraft.
- [Yemenia Airlines completed its purchase of 10 A320s](#) from Airbus, following an MOU signed at the Dubai air show.
- Airbus increased the list price of all its aircraft by an average of 5.8%. This is the first price increase since January 2008.
- Chinese [CDB Leasing Co., Ltd. \(CLC\)](#), [signed a MoU on cooperation in aircraft financing and leasing](#). CLC will provide financing support by way of sale and leaseback transactions with its airline customers in the amount of up to four billion US dollars over the next five years.
- Airbus delivered its [6,000th aircraft](#)—an A380 for Emirates Airlines (this is the carrier's eighth A380).
- At the end of January the Airbus order book amounted to 3,740. For more details on orders and deliveries, please see the bottom of the next page.

Astrium

- EADS North America won a five-year contract to provide [commercial radar satellite data to the US government](#) for use in intelligence, military and homeland security applications.
- Astrium announced [strong 2009](#) results. New orders totaled more than € 8 billion, and sales increased by 11% to over € 4.8 billion

- The Spanish Ministry of the Interior ordered [12 EC135s](#). The aircraft will be assembled in Albacete (Spain).
